RUSSIAN STRATEGIC & CONCEPTUAL DOCUMENTS

Very deliberate on such themes as:

- Russian role as a global world power to be achieved on the basis of establishing mutually beneficial strategic partnerships in a multipolar world environment.
- Security threats to Russia emanating from the Euro-Atlantic and Central Asian regions. It is focused on main approaches to counter them and on Russian priorities in developing relations with key players, including: CIS states, international governmental organizations (UN, CSTO – Collective Security Treaty Organization, EEA – Eurasian Economic Organization, SCO – Shanghai
